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Introduction

DECISION-PLUS thanks you for having selected the DQuotes Software as your investment tool. You now have a very powerful instrument that will help you to make the right decisions.

This Help Manual was designed to follow a logical order as you learn and use the software. It will guide you, step by step, as you progress. The elements of the software are simple and standardized; you will be able to understand each new feature as it is presented to you.

System requirements

- A) **Computer:** IBM PC or compatible, Intel Pentium or higher.
- B) **Memory:** A minimum of 16 MB is necessary. 32 MB is recommended.
- C) **Operating System:** Compatible operating systems include Windows 95, Windows 98, Windows NT and Windows 2000.
- D) **Hard Disk:** The more available disk space, the more information you can save. A high-speed hard disk is also an asset, since the system saves to the disk frequently. Three megabytes are required for the VISION installation.
- E) **Modem:** To update the quotes via the Internet, you can use an ordinary modem, a high speed modem (cable modem, dsl) or a Local Area Network (LAN).

Installation

BACKUP: Although, the installation program is designed to avoid deleting data related to MAGI-BOURSE or a previous version of VISION installed in your computer, **we always recommend** that you make a back up copy of all important information saved to your hard disk before the installation.

The installation program will create a new directory for the program and a subdirectory for the stock exchange data.

You can abort the installation procedure at any moment by pressing the <Esc> key.

Insert the CD in the CD-ROM drive.

- The CD-ROM menu automatically offers you the choice of English or French.
- If the installation menu fails to appear, use the Windows Start command (on the lower left corner of your computer screen), then click on "run". A dialog box will appear, then type in d:\setup.exe. D: being the CD-ROM letter. Replace this letter if your CD-ROM uses a different one. You can also access your CD-ROM by opening the "My Computer" icon on the desktop.
- Click on the <OK> button.

DQuotes is a software package that combines simplicity, speed, and flexibility to build an on-screen list of securities in real time or deferred time. DQuotes permits up to 10 custom-built lists of securities. In the Static mode, these lists are refreshed with each update; in Continuous mode, the quotes will blink whenever there is a transaction on the market.

DQuotes has only one display of quotes, on which 10 programmable lists can be posted.



Explanations in this manual are designed to follow the menu bar. When you click on that bar, you will easily be able to find the explanation that you want.


File Menu

The File Menu contains the print setup, and the **Exit**.



Edit Menu

The Edit Menu contains the following functions:



1. Add a security

This function will open a dialogue box entitled **Add a security** that will enable you to add a security to the active list. If you wish to add a title to another list, you must first open that other list.

- You can also click on the **Add** icon. 

2. Delete the current security

This function will immediately remove the selected title from the active list.


- You can also click on the **Delete** icon. 

3. Add/Modify an alarm

This function will open a box entitled Add/Modify an alarm, which contains two tabs: Alerts and Conditions of Alarms.

FIRST select the list for which you wish to add or modify an alarm.

- You can also click on the **Add/Modify** icon.

a Conditions of alarms

The Conditions of alarms display five boxes; you can activate one or all of them.

- **Price:** Two boxes allow you to set a maximum price and a minimum price.
 - In the first box, select one of the following:
 - Last price,
 - Bid,
 - Offer,
 - Highest,
 - Lowest.
 - Then, in the second box select one of the following:
 - Is greater than [$>$],
 - Is equal to or greater than [$>=$],
 - Is less than [$<$],
 - Is equal to or less than [$<=$].
 - Finally, enter an amount in dollars and cents in the third box.
- **\$ Variation:** variation in dollars
 - First, in the first box indicate whether the variation in dollars should be:
 - Rising
 - Falling, or
 - Mixed (it does not matter whether the variation is rising or falling).
 - Then, in the second box, indicate whether the variation should be
 - Greater than [$>$], or
 - Equal to or Greater than [$>=$]the sum that you will enter in the third box.
 - Finally, enter an amount in dollars and cents in the third box.

- **% Variation:** variation in percentage
 - First, in the first box indicate whether the variation in percentage should be:
 - Rising
 - Falling, or
 - Mixed (it does not matter whether the variation is rising or falling).
 - Then, in the second box, indicate whether the variation should be
 - Greater than [$>$], or
 - Equal to or Greater than [$>=$]the figure that you will enter in the third box.
 - Finally, enter a percentage (a figure) in the third box.

- **Transaction Volume**
 - Enter a figure in the box:
The number of shares traded must be equal to or greater than the number you have entered.

- **Number of transactions**
 - Enter a figure in the box:
The number of transactions must be equal to or greater than the number you have entered.

- Select "One of the above conditions" or "All of the above conditions."

b Alarms

You can select one, two, or all three of the choices that are proposed.

1 Activate your computer's buzzer for this alarm.

2 Send an e-mail notice to:

- Enter the e-mail address to which you wish to send the notice.

3 Specific text.

- Enter the exact text that you wish to receive. Be sure to specify all necessary information, the exchange, purchase price, number of shares purchased, etc. It is possible that this alarm may be activated only in the future, perhaps a month or more.
- Click < OK >. A small yellow bell will be displayed beside the security.

4. Activate/Deactivate alarm

This function is active only if you have one or more alarms in operation. When you select this function you can temporarily deactivate an alarm (the bell becomes black) or reactivate it (the bell again becomes yellow). This does not cancel the alarm.


5. Delete alarm

This function is active only if you have programmed one or more alarms. If an alarm has been placed on the active security (on the screen), the alarm is removed immediately by selecting this function.

- You can also click on the Delete icon. 

6. List Descriptions


This function opens a dialogue box called List Descriptions which allows you to personalize your lists by adding a name (for example: List 1-- John) and a description (for example: TSE).



- Click on Modify and add a name and description.

View Menu

The View Menu contains the following functions:



1. Toolbar

The Toolbar function allows you to display the icons or to stop displaying them.



2. Toolbar text

The Toolbar text function allows you to display the text beneath the buttons (or to stop displaying the text...).



3. Status bar

The Status bar function allows you to display, along the bottom of the screen, a bar that names the function of the icon where the pointer is placed (or to stop displaying ...).

4. Fractions

The Fractions function allows the monitor to display the price of securities in fractions for customers who deal on US markets.

5. Reached alarms


A Tripped alarm is an alarm where all required conditions have been attained. This function opens a box called Tripped Alarms, and enables you to visualize all tripped alarms. You can deactivate, reactivate, delete, and modify the alarms from this box.

- You can also click on the icon Reached Alarms. 

6. All alarms

This function opens a box called All alarms, which enables you to view the alarms installed in DQuotes, sorted according to symbols. You can deactivate, reactive, delete, and modify the alarms from this box.

- You can also click on the icon All alarms.



Update Menu

The Update Menu contains the following functions:



1. Auto updating (On/Off)

When the Auto updating function of the Update Menu is selected, your monitor will blink for each transaction; these are continuous quotes. The monitor is always animated. This function presupposes that you are continually connected to the Internet.

- You can also click on the automatic update icon. 

2. Update current security (snapshot)

The Update current security (snapshot) function of the Update Menu allows you to take a snapshot of the security that has been selected. These are static quotes, and are not updated. If you want/need to know the current situation, take another snapshot. This function is of interest to investors who cannot spend the whole day seated in front of their computers.

- You can also click on the update current security (snapshot) icon. 

3. Update all securities (snapshot)

The Update all securities (snapshot) function of the Update Menu allows you to take a "family portrait" of all of the securities on the list. These are static quotes, and are not updated. If you want/need to know the current situation, take another snapshot. This function is of interest to investors who cannot spend the whole day seated in front of their computers.

- You can also click on the All Securities Snapshot icon. 

4. Update all active alarms (snapshot)

This function of the Update Menu enables you to take a snapshot of the situation of all of your active alarms. Alarms that have been reached assume a mauve colour.

- You can also click on the All active Alarms Snapshot icon. 

5. Formulas

This function of the Update Menu opens the Formulas box which enables you to obtain a list of 35 securities selected according to the following criteria:


- The most active securities (Volume),
- The greatest variations in Price (\$), and
- The greatest variations in Price (%).

The date of the most recent update is displayed near the Update button.

- You can also click on the Formulas icon. 

Tools Menu

The Tools menu contains the following functions:



1. Test feed

This function in the Tools Menu opens the box "Available Servers," and is used by the technical support team in case of difficulty.

2. Set highlight delay

This function in the Tools Menu opens the box "Change the marking period," i.e. change the length of time that a security remains highlighted after a transaction.

3. Internet Configuration

This function in the Tools menu opens the box "Configuration Proxy" (a system used in several companies), and is used mostly by technical support personnel or by some office workers

4. Options

This function in the Tools Menu opens the box "Configuration" that allows the user to personalize the screen and tools. This box offers three choices:

a Colours and Fonts

You can change the appearance of the screen (background, text, alarms...) by choosing the colours in the display on the right-hand side of the screen.

b Alarms


This tab gives you a choice of alarms (Click on the Browse button), a choice of sounding cadences (in seconds), and a choice of up-dating schedules in the "snapshot mode" (in minutes). Of course, these alarms will work only if you are connected to the Internet.

c E-mail

If you want the alarm to send an e-mail message, the e-mail address must be entered in the first box. (Return Address...) The second box (Server Address...) is reserved for the technical support personnel.

Help Menu

The Help Menu contains the following functions:




1. About DQuotes

This function of the Help Menu identifies the version of your software package and supplies information concerning your computer.

2. Register


This function of the Help Menu opens the Register box, and allows you to obtain access to the database without having to type your Client Number and password each time. Enter your Client Number, (the serial number you received when you purchased the DQuotes Software package) and your Password (the password you received when you purchased the DQuotes Software package).

Trade Now

The DQuotes software package allows customers of E*TRADE Canada to trade on-line with a simple click on the Trade the current security button.

and click on the following button: 


The first time you click on that button the following window will appear:


Beta Function

The strength of the DQuotes display is its simplicity. All information is displayed in a Table format, as lines of securities and columns of parameters. Not all customers have the same needs.

On an experimental basis, therefore, this function enables the customer to add, delete, or reorganize the parameters displayed on the screen.

To gain access to the list of parameters available or displayed on the screen:

- Place the cursor on the M-Symbol line, click with the Left Button (Contextual) of the mouse, and a dialogue box will appear, divided into Available parameters, and Displayed parameters.



In this box, you can:

1 Add a parameter to the Display

- Click on a parameter on the Available list and click on <Add>. The parameter will be transferred to the list of parameters displayed, and will be displayed as the last column on the screen.

2 Insert an available parameter

- Click on a parameter on the Available list. Then click on the position where it is to appear on the list of Parameters displayed. Finally, click on <Insert>.

NOTE: The parameters listed from top to bottom on the list of parameters displayed will be displayed on screen in the same order, from left to right. This will help you insert the parameters in their proper order.

3 Remove a displayed parameter

- Click on a parameter displayed in the right hand box and click on <Remove>. This parameter will appear on the Available list, on the left.

4 The <Default> button resets all parameters to their original default status.

5 Click on <OK> to accept or <Cancel> to cancel the operation.
